

County of San Francisco

A diverse and extensive range of treatment services is available to Prop. 36 clients in San Francisco. Cultural, ethnic, and sexual orientation issues related to treatment are addressed.



San Francisco values a public health approach to treating drug addiction. The entire team of Prop. 36 players are vital, including those from the criminal justice system, but public health leadership is key to the program's success.
